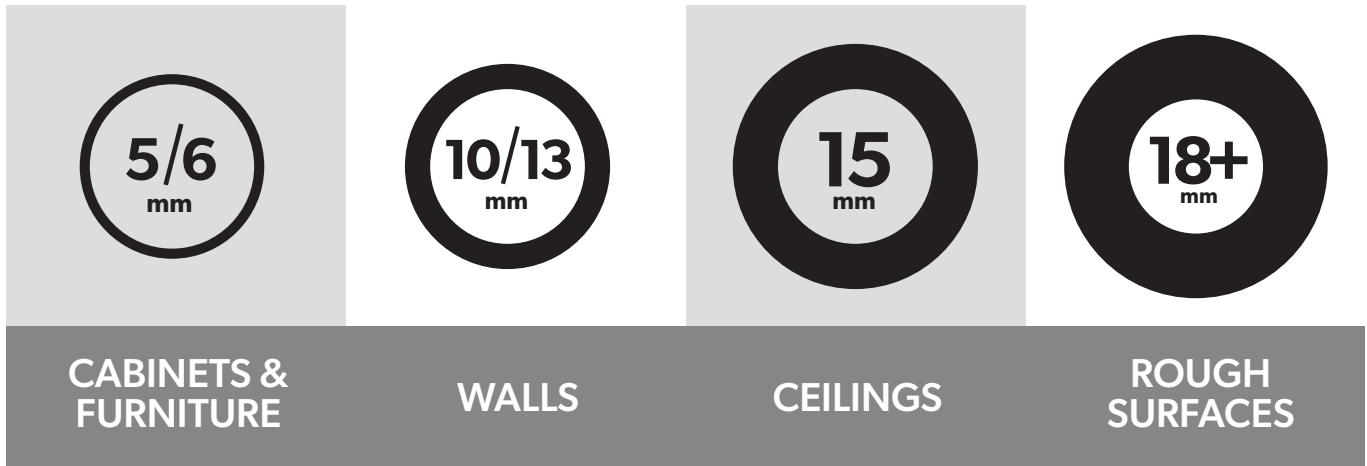


# Roller Refill Refresher

The most important consideration when choosing a roller refill is the **Pile Height**, sometimes referred to as “Nap”. This is the “fluffiness” of the roller, or the length of the fibers measured in millimetres (mm). The surface of your project (substrate) will often dictate the pile height you choose.



## Common Roller Materials:

### Microfibre

- Ideal for smooth & semi-smooth surfaces
- For use with most paints & sheens
- Superior paint pick-up & release
- No linting or spatter
- Creates professional finish

### Fabric

- Ideal for smooth & semi-smooth surfaces
- Use with most paints & sheens
- Low linting

### Foam

- Ideal for cabinets, steel doors & trim
- Ideal for melamine, urethane & other high gloss paints
- No linting
- Creates ultra smooth finish

### High Density Lint Free

- Ideal for smooth & semi-smooth surfaces
- Use with most paints & sheens
- Good paint pick-up and release
- Creates smooth finish

### Mohair

- Ideal for ultra smooth surfaces
- Ideal for melamine, urethane & other high gloss paints
- Use with most latex & oil-based enamels
- Low lint, no shedding
- Creates smooth finish

### Flock

- All the uses and benefits of foam with a no-bubble finish.
