HOW TO PAINT A FRONT DOOR INSTRUCTIONS

SHOPPING LIST

Corotech Command Paint

Painter's Tape

Angular Brush

Wooster Big Green Mini Roller
Atmosphere Drop Cloth

PREP

- 1. Select your paint. We recommend Corotech Command Paint for faster drying time.
- 2. Remove any non-permanent hardware.
- 3. If there is peeling paint, use a paint scraper to remove loose bits, being careful to wipe away debris.
- 4. Clean with TSP, then rinse and let dry completely.
- 5. Cover permanent hardware like hinges using painter's tape.

SAND & PRIME

- 1. Sand door very lightly with fine-grit sandpaper to rough up surface and wipe away dust with a dry cloth.
- 2. If your door has been previously painted or is material like wood, check with our Paint Shop experts as you may need to prime first.

PAINT: USING COMMAND*

- 1. Using your chosen paint colour, apply with a brush and roller. Use the angled brush to paint in the tight angles, trim any windows or hardware, then roll the larger areas.
- 2. Once the door is dry for a minimum of 1 hour apply the 2nd coat.
- 3. The second coat will be dry in 1 hour and the door can be closed. Allow 24 hours before high usage.

*Instructions may differ pending Benjamin Moore product chosen. Please consult a sales associate.

IMPORTANT! High humidity and cool temperatures will result in longer drying times.
